



# Champagne & Sparkling Wines

**101 Cava Brut Reserva Rene Barbier, Spain, N.V. (12% abv)**

A very elegant Cava, with clean citrus on the nose, backed by soft fruit aromas of peach and melon; purity and a fine mousse mark the palate.

**Bottle £22.00 – Glass 125ml £5.00**

**102 Prosecco Itynera DOC Treviso Brut, Italy, N.V. (11% abv)**

Richly fruity with a flowery, delicate fragrance & a finely balanced long tasting finish.

**103 Crémant de Bourgogne Rosé Brut Simonnet-Febvre, France, N.V. (12% abv)**

Salmon pink with aromas of raspberry and vanilla. The palate is rounded with a fine mousse, fresh acidity and pretty bramble and wild strawberry fruit, which linger on the finish.

# White Wines

## WINE TO STIMULATE THE PALATE

### **206 Terre Del Noce Pinot Grigio, Italy, 2015 (12% abv)**

Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth, and a clean crisp finish.

**Bottle £16.75 - Glass 250ml £5.95 - Glass 175ml £4.45 - Glass 125ml £2.95**

### **207 Morandé Pionero Sauvignon Blanc Reserva 2016, Maule, Chile**

An exceptional Sauvignon Blanc with really vivid aromas of grapefruit, peach and herbs. The palate is juicy and full of flavour, yet dry and refreshing to finish.

**Bottle £16.50 - Glass 250 ml £5.75 - Glass 175ml £4.20 - Glass 125ml £2.85**

### **215 Grand Ardeche Chardonnay, France, 2014 (13.5% abv)**

This wine is shimmering pale yellow in colour. On the nose it reveals aromas of vanilla and brioche with hints of honey and acacia. This is a well-balanced wine, ample and generous in the mouth with flavours of almond paste and vanilla. The finish is bright and fresh.

### **218 Coopers Creek Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2016 (13% abv)**

This is absolutely classic Marlborough Sauvignon: vibrant gooseberry, passionfruit and nectarine backed with hints of herbaceousness. Impressive weight of flavour on the palate with richness and texture and a long finish.

## FRESH & ELEGANT IN STYLES

### **203 Mon Roc Ugni Blanc, France, 2015 (11% abv)**

Aromas of white fruits, peach, citrus, grapefruit and a hint of peony lead to a crisp, fruity palate that is both easy-drinking and refreshing.

### **230 Domaine du Haut-Perron Touraine Sauvignon, France, 2015 (12.5% abv)**

A fresh, grassy nose is followed by a palate full of green apple and citrus fruit, and even a touch of blackcurrant bud. Dry yet generous, with a long, crisp finish.

### **208 Morgenhof Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa 2015 (13.5% abv)**

On the nose an array of tropical fruit notes such as litchi, limes, passion fruit and guava are displayed. This wine also exhibits a tangy – savoury component reminiscent of the sea breezes that influence the climate. A truly delicious wine with crispness on the palate lingering into nice finish.

### **217 Pouilly-Fumé 'La Moynerie' Domaine Michel Redde, France, 2014 (13% abv)**

Pouilly-Fumé 'La Moynerie' is the Redde family's flagship wine and is a blend of wines originating from the main soils of the appellation. The finished wine expresses the density, aromatic minerality and aline purity of the soils.

## SMOOTH & FRUITY

### **201 Isonto Chenin Blanc, South Africa, 2015 (13% abv)**

Isonto Chenin Blanc is an immediately appealing crisp wine, light enough to be drunk without food or with lighter meals such as young goats' cheeses, grilled chicken and salads.

### **213 Viognier Selection Dellas Vin de Pays d'Oc, France, 2015 (12.5% abv)**

Bursting with Viognier character: apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit. The palate is both smooth and fresh, with hints of spice.

## AROMATIC VARIETIES

### **202 Cuvée Louis Vincent de Georges Duboeuf, Blanc, France, (12.5% abv)**

Pale yellow in colour with greenish golden tinges. Aromas of white flowers and citrus fruit; fresh yet rich on the palate.

### **212 New Hall Vineyard Pinot Gris Reserve, England, 2014 (10.5% abv)**

## CHARDONNAY IN DIFFERENT STYLES

### **205 First Fleet Chardonnay, South-Eastern Australia, 2016 (13% abv)**

A delicious Chardonnay that captures the pioneering spirit of the first voyages to Australia in a crisp, modern style. Red apple and melon fruit fills a palate that is dry yet well rounded, making this a versatile accompaniment to food.

### **209 Viu Manent Estate Collection Reserva Chardonnay, Chile, 2015 (13.5% abv)**

White peach, nectarine and citrus fruits leap out of the glass, preceding a ripe, mid-weight palate of peach, pineapple and a subtle cinnamon note.

### **231 Deakin Estate Chardonnay, Australia, 2015 (13.5% abv)**

This Chardonnay shows aromas of ripe pear, nectarine and apple. The palate is ripe and smooth with delicious fruit character without being over the top.

### **214 Mâcon-Lugny Les Genièvres Louis Latour, France, 2015 (13% abv)**

The 2010 Macon Lugny "Les Genièvres" is characterised by a pale yellow colour and an intense nose with notes of Muscat. The mouth is ample and offers delicious aromas of exotic fruit, especially mango. Very beautiful spicy finish with a touch of ginger.

### **233 Saveurs de Lyre, France, 2013 (12.5% abv)**

This wine is elegant and harmonious. Supple and delicate on the palate, with mineral notes coming through. The blend Auxerrois, Chardonnay gives the wine a good balance and a long finish. A perfect companion for appetizers, grilled meats and fish with sauce.

**216 Chablis Domaine Sainte Claire, Jean Marc Brocard, France, 2015 (12.5% abv)**

Brilliant colour with green highlights. The nose is precise, pure, chiselled, with slightly iodized notes of citrus fruit. The mouth has a classic structure, crunchy and delicious, with notes of citrus fruit. The finish is very appetizing, with stony, salty minerality.

**232 St Andrews Chardonnay Wakefield, Australia, 2015 (13.5% abv)**

This is a medium-bodied yet sumptuous wine with an enjoyable creaminess. Flavours of juicy white fleshed stone fruit are evident along with cleansing citrus at the finish.

## Red Wines

### FRESH, JUICY & YOUTHFULL RED

**306 D'Alamel by Lapostolle Cabernet, Valle Central, Chile, 2014 (13.5% abv)**

Very expressive, aromas of fresh red fruit such as plum and cherries.

**330 D'Alamel by Lapostolle Merlot, Chile, 2013 (13.5% abv)**

A round, voluptuous Merlot with plum and cherry aromas, a juicy feel in the mouth and a long, smooth finish. The oak adds a touch of spicy complexity.

**319 Promised Land Cabernet Merlot Wakefield, Australia, 2015 (13.5% abv)**

Aromas of plum, red berries and liquorice along with a hint of spice, cedar and vanilla characters from oak influence. A soft, round and gloriously fleshy palate delivers flavours of ripe plum, red berries along with subtle liquorice and chocolate, finishing in a smooth and elegant fashion.

**331 Deakin Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia, 2015 (13.5% abv)**

A characteristically elegant Cabernet, full of cassis, cinnamon and hints of spicy oak. The palate is medium-bodied and juicy, with a nice savoury finish.

**311 Côtes du Rhône Vidal-Fleury, France, 2013 (14% abv)**

Brilliant garnet in colour, with a classic Rhône nose of bramble fruits and heady spice. The medium-bodied palate has fresh and snappy red fruit surrounded by firm and persistent tannins.

**320 Beaujolais-Villages Henry Fessy, France, 2015 (12.5% abv)**

This wine is deep in colour with fruity and floral aromas. In the mouth, it has a lovely substance, with hints of blackcurrant.

## BORDEAUX / CLARETS

### **322 Château Mayne Vieux, Castillon, 2013, Bordeaux, France (13.5% abv)**

The nose is a pleasant bouquet of ripe red fruits, with undergrowth and grilled notes. After a subtle attack, the mouth gains in volume and roundness, showing fine tannins.

### **332 Chateau Queyron Lartigue St Emilion, 2012, Bordeaux, France (13.5% abv)**

Offering spectacular value, this pure-Merlot Saint-Emilion is plump, fresh and filled with savoury-tinged plum fruit. From a notably charming vintage, this is ready to drink and very nicely balanced.

### **324 Château Caronne Ste Gemme Haut-Medoc, 2008, Bordeaux, France (13% abv)**

Purity and focus of flavour meets richness of texture in this classic Haut-Médoc. Blackberry and blackcurrant fruit are given extra complexity by cigar box and floral notes. There is excellent finesse and depth all the way through to the finish.

## SYRAH OR SHIRAZ?

### **301 Isonto Shiraz/Cinsault, South Africa, 2014 (14% abv)**

A fresh fruit driven red with plum and cherry aromas. The palate is medium bodied with broad rounded fruit and a pleasant lingering finish.

### **310 GSM Syrah/Grenache/Mouvedre Vidal-Fleury, Rhone Valley, France, 2013 (13.5% abv)**

GSM is made by the wonderful team at Vidal-Fleury and has access to some of the highest quality vineyards in the Rhone Valley. Their GSM shows great bright red varietal fruit of raspberry and cherry with underlying savoury tone.

### **314 Margaret River Shiraz McHenry Hohnen, Australia, 2013 (14.5% abv)**

The warm northerly exposure delivers a richness and full flavoured ripeness to the wine. Some fruit also came from the south where cooler conditions add a touch of spice - Rich aromas of currant muffin, plum, briar berry and smoked ham-hock lead to a lush and rich palate.

## PINOT NOIR IN DIFFERENT STYLES

### **303 Terra Andina Reserva Pinot Noir, Chile, 2015 (13.5% abv)**

A fragrant Pinot Noir with notes of cherry, Turkish apricot, orange peel and liquorice. Medium-bodied and delicate in the mouth, with an appealing smooth texture and long finish.

**Bottle £18.00 - Glass 250ml £6.10 - Glass 175ml £4.60 - Glass 125ml £3.15**

### **309 Featherdrop Hill Pinot Noir, New Zealand, 2015 (14% abv)**

Ripe, sweet dark fruit aromas and a subtle touch of oak are followed on the palate by soft, rounded, red fruit flavours, supported by fine grain tannins.

### **315 Viu Manent Secret Pinot Noir, Chile, 2013 (14% abv)**

This lovely Chilean Pinot has a rich nose of red fruit, mint, blackberry, spice and violet. The palate is dry, medium bodied and shows a crisp, round character with silky smooth tannins. Good fruit replays of the mint, tangy berries and deep dark fruit overtones with a gentle hint of oak that leads to a satisfying, medium finish.

## HERBS & SPICES

### **302 Valdemoreda Tempranillo, Spain, 2014 (13% abv)**

Medium ruby colour with a lifted nose of sweet spices, blue fruits, white pepper, cloves and lavender. Dry with elegant bright raspberry and blueberry, light vanilla bean, sweet spices and delicate pepper.

**Bottle £14.00 - Glass 250ml £4.55 - Glass 175ml £3.40 - Glass 125ml £2.30**

### **307 Finca la Colonia Malbec, Argentina, 2016 (14% abv)**

Sweet and spicy aromas, reminiscent of black pepper. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish.

### **318 Gran Reserva Malbec Viu Manent, Chile, 2013 (13.5% abv)**

Deep and intense purple in color. The elegant nose features aromas of red fruits, forest fruits, cherries, blueberries, and subtle notes of black pepper and blond tobacco that lend complexity.

### **313 Brouilly, 2014 (13% abv)**

Of a garnet colour, this wine reveals an elegant and floral nose with notes of violet and hawthorn. In the mouth it is round and persistent with velvety tannins and a lovely strawberry finish.

### **334 Fattoria La Valentina Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Italy, 2013 (13% abv)**

First-class peppery Montepulciano, with all the exuberant fruit and spicy character of the grape, plus an extra degree of refinement from this excellent producer.

### **316 Fleurie Henry Fessy, France, 2014 (13% abv)**

This Fleurie has a very pleasant bouquet of red fruits mixed with floral tones. In the mouth the red fruit is rich and concentrated backed with a persistent finish.

## AROMATIC VARIETIES

### **304 Domaine La Prade Merlot, France, 2015**

A smooth, spicy Merlot with aromas of plums, berries and tobacco. The palate is medium-full and packed with both fruit and savoury flavours.

### **305 Terre Del Noce Merlot, Italy, 2014 (12.5% abv)**

Smooth, easy-drinking Merlot with plum and red cherry fruit, and a hint of dark chocolate on the finish.

### **333 Cloof Pinotage, South Africa, 2013 (14% abv)**

The bold, concentrated flavours of this wine are directly attributable to the tiny yield of mature bush vines growing under extreme conditions. Richly textured with notes of smoke, blackberry, plum with some spiciness and elegant oaky notes.

### **321 Bodegas Valdemar Conde De Valdemar Crianza, Spain, 2012 (13.5% abv)**

Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with aromatic complexity lasting through to the finish.

# Rosé Wines

## SPRING DROPS

### **401 Isono Pinotage Rosé, South Africa, 2014 (13% abv)**

Like the Isono Chenin Blanc and Shiraz/Cinsault this wine is from the Swartland region of the Western Cape, the wine is a pretty pale pink and is scented with aromas summer berries and cherries.

### **403 Pinot Grigio Rosé Mannara, Veneto Italy, 2015 (12% abv)**

## BEFORE THE END

### **500 Muscat de Beaumes-de-Venise, France 2014**

Very pretty sweet flowery nose with lifted floral elements. Rich-textured concentrated palate with nice balance and good acidity. Very lush and forward.

# Ports

### **Ferreira Ruby Port, Portugal, N.V.**

Young and fruity. Usually aged no more than three years. Should be consumed when it is quite young for the essence of its charm is its spicy, fresh vibrancy.

### **Ferreira Late Bottled Vintage Port, Portugal, 2011**

The intense aroma is dominated by very ripe black fruit (blackcurrant, blackberry and prune), along with chocolate, cocoa, floral aromas and a slight hint of spices (pepper). In the mouth it is a full-bodied wine with great balance between sweetness and richness of structure.

### **Ferreira Quita Do Porto Tawny Port, Portugal, 10 years old**

The impeccable balance and structure shows that this wonderful Tawny Port comes from a single vineyard. The consistency in the flavours suggests this is from only one source. Look for dried fruit, plum, chocolate and vanilla aromas. It is sweet, but in no way cloying. Full-bodied with a very long and elegant finish.
